### Examples of what your donations can do

- **\$35** allows for two Guatemalan Sister Parish representatives to travel to the capital city to participate in educational and ecumenical meetings with other SP representatives from all over the country.
- **\$50** allows a staff member to travel to one of the farthest communities, bringing them news about you and bringing YOU news, letters, and photos of them.
- **\$75** allows the Guatemalan Sister Parish Center to have one month of DSL internet connection, which keeps delegates in touch with home, and which keeps you in touch with your Central American community.
- **\$100** pays for the US administrative office for one month.
- **\$200** allows for the El Salvador CCR office to continue working with the different communities in Chalatenango that participate in Sister Parish.
- **\$250** allows staff to travel to several Sister Parish communities, bringing them news about you and bringing YOU news, letters, and photos of them
- **\$300** pays for all of the Guatemalan SP representatives (22) to hold a weekend meeting of fellowship, education, and cultural exchange. It provides them with room and board and travel money.
- **\$500** subsidizes educational activities in Guatemala planned and carried out by the Guatemalans. These activities are important since most communities do not otherwise have access to relevant information about local issues that affect their communities (CAFTA, Mining, Hydroelectric projects, the electoral process, human rights, etc.)
- **\$600** pays for one month of operations in Guatemala, or 3 months of operations in El Salvador, or for a Guatemalan or Salvadoran to travel to the U.S. as a participant in annual meetings with the Northern churches.
- **\$1500** allows 30 representatives from Guatemala and El Salvador, who participant in Sister Parish, to gather together for a weekend of fellowship, educational activities, and cultural exchange. This activity reinforces the ecumenical and solidarity aspects of our program.
