Educational Topic: Climate Change



The educational topic opened with a documentary *Home* that gave visuals to the dramatic shift in climate patterns and role of human activity in those shifts. Later, representatives shared their basic knowledge of climate change by reflecting on the documentary and changes in climate patterns in their own communities. Two volunteers from UPAVIM facilitated discussion and encouraged representatives to provide solutions that work in the context of life in Guatemala. The volunteers also

presented general information on climate patterns and reasons for those shifts in patterns.
