### **Praying for Chichipate –**

*Because we are sister parishes, when we pray for Iglesia Santo Domingo we discover that we're also praying for St. Thomas. Despite our different cultures and situations, it turns out that our greatest hopes and deepest longings are congruent – they match up. That's what sisterhood means and it is reflected in these prayers. Please choose what prayers feel right to you and make them yours.*

### **A Prayer for Healing of Creation**

Stir up your power, O God, and save your good creation. Forests fall, rivers flood, crops fail, and the air is thick with so much burning. Free us from the powerful who destroy the air, water, and land. Free us from desires and choices that feed their power. Frustrate their violence, expose their lies, disrupt their schemes, and strengthen people everywhere who serve and protect the earth. Pour out your justice that rolls down like mighty waters, in the name of our savior and brother Jesus. **Amen.**

### **A Prayer for Farmers**

Creator God, you made a world where, used wisely, lands, waters, plants and creatures can meet the needs of everyone. Bless all farmers, their animals, and the land that feeds us all. Protect farmlands and ranches from drought and flood. Grant that everyone may have a fair portion of the harvest and accept our gratitude in the name of Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. **Amen.**

### **A Prayer for Peace**

God most mighty, God most merciful, our sacred stories tell us that you help and save your people. You are the fortress: may there be no more armed conflict. You are the harvest: may there be no more hunger. You are the light: may no one die alone or in despair. We pray for all who suffer from violence.
